RACE DAY INFORMATION

Start Time

Race start time is 6:15 PM. If you are a few minutes late, we can accommodate you. The race will have a chip start.

Headlamps

Sunset is at 6:58 PM. You may need a headlamp – keep in mind it gets dark earlier in the woods.

Cutoff Time

Participants must finish the race by 7:50 PM (21 min/mi pace). Anyone not on pace to finish by this time accepts the responsibility to know the course and complete it without any support.

How to Wear Your Bib

Please wear your bib in front, visible, and horizontal to assure we get a good chip read for you. Keep away from metal (zippers) and electronics (gps watches and smartphones).

Restrooms

Restrooms are located at the pool, near the start/finish.

COURSE INFORMATION

Theme

The 2025 Fall Running Series theme is **Decide in a Flash – Win in a Dash**.

Course

The course will be between 4.85 and 5 miles depending on how well you do at the checkpoint, which will be at mile 4.5. This week’s “Decide in a Flash” game is **Are you ODD?**

Course Markings

- All course marking materials are Western Reserve Racing branded.
- These include ground flags, coroplast signs, and streamer tape.
- A course marker will be found about every 0.1 mile. After turns, there will be a sequence of 3-4 ground flags and/or streamers in the trees as confidence markers.
- Watch for slippery surfaces such as wooden steps and bridges.

AID STATIONS

Fluid Station

There will be a water stop at mile 3.5. Participants are also encouraged to carry water.

Finish Line

Water and a variety of sweet and salty snacks will be served at the finish line.

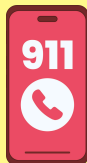
